

Clock Hours FAQ for the Robyn Gobbel Webinar Series

This FAQ addresses common questions regarding the process of earning clock hours for completing the webinar series with Robyn Gobbel. Participants can refer to this information for clarity on requirements, deadlines, registration, and contact details for further assistance.

How many clock hours can I earn by completing the webinar series?

Participants can earn 10 clock hours upon completion of the webinar series.

What are the requirements to earn clock hours?

- Participants must either attend the webinars live or watch the recorded webinars.
- Additionally, participants must complete a Nearpod Learning Module for each webinar.

Where can I find the video recordings and links to the learning modules?

 All video recordings and links to the learning modules are available on the Roots of Inclusion website.

Is there a deadline to complete the Nearpod learning modules for this series?

 Yes, participants have until May 31st, 2024, to complete the Nearpod learning modules.

What if I am not able to watch the webinars and complete the modules by May 31st, 2024?

We will be putting together an on-demand learning module with this content after the completion of this series. Anyone who registered but was not able to complete the series at this time, will be notified of additional learning options.

Can I earn partial clock hours for attending only some of the webinars?

 No, partial clock hours are not available for this series. Participants must complete all webinars and corresponding Nearpod learning modules to earn the full 10 clock hours.

How do I register for clock hours certification?

Participants seeking clock hours must register on PDEnroller for this event.
Registration will enable easy access to their clock hours certification.

When will I receive notification that my clock hours are complete?

 Notification of completion will be provided after the May 8th webinar and as learning modules are completed for all 5 webinars.

Do these clock hours qualify for Educational Leadership and Equity Requirements?
